The Board of Mayor and City Commissioners met in a Regular City Meeting on Tuesday, October 14, 2014.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Powers, to approve the minutes of the September 9, 2014 meeting. Five voted aye.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall, to approve the minutes of the September 25, 2014 special called meeting. Five voted aye.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Wigfall, seconded by Commissioner Powers, to change from vertical parking to parallel parking across from city hall on 3rd Street. Five voted aye.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall, to accept the USDA \$150,000 imminent threat/water line preservation grant (with no match) for the Raulstontown Road repairs. Five voted aye.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall, to close 6th and 7th Street on October 31st for a block party/pep rally for the South Pittsburg vs. Marion County football game. Five voted aye.

After a public hearing, a **Motion** to pass on second (2nd) and final reading **Ordinance #751** (An Ordinance for the City of South Pittsburg to Amend the

Zoning Ordinance of the City of South Pittsburg Pertaining to Adult-Oriented Establishments) was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall. Five voted aye.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Lancaster, to pass on first (1st) reading **Ordinance #753** (An Ordinance of the City of South Pittsburg to Amend the Zoning Map for the City of South Pittsburg, TN, to Rezone Property from the C-1 Local Highway Commercial District to the C-3 Central Business District). Five voted aye.

A **Motion** to adjourn the meeting was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Powers. Five voted aye.
