A **Motion** was made by Mayor Dawkins, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall, to approve the minutes of the July 14, 2015 meeting. Commissioner King asked that the Motion to remove City Administrator Sammy Burrows, seconded by Commissioner Powers, be included in the Minutes. Roll call vote: Commissioner Lancaster, no; Commissioner Wigfall, no; Commissioner Powers, yes; Commissioner King, yes; Mayor Dawkins, no. This was amended prior to this meeting (see page three). Commissioner Powers asked that his vote on the appointment of Debbie Hughes, Elderly Housing Board, be changed to a 'no' vote. Roll call vote regarding Elderly Housing Board: Commissioner Lancaster, yes; Commissioner Wigfall, yes; Commissioner Powers, no; Commissioner King, no; Mayor Dawkins, yes. After Motion was made to approve the July minutes, five voted aye. Mayor Dawkins stated roll call voting will be implemented in all voting from this day forward.

Commissioner King read a statement from his brother and former employee, Billy King, regarding his resignation from the City of South Pittsburg. Mayor Dawkins requested that this letter be included in the Minutes of the August 10, 2015 City Commission Meeting.

Police Chief Bobby Simpson recommended that Officer Brenda Roth be promoted to Sergeant. A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Lancaster, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall, to promote Roth to Sergeant. Roll call vote: Commissioner

Roll call vote: Commissioner Lancaster, yes; Commissioner Wigfall, yes; Commissioner Powers, yes; Commissioner King, yes; Mayor Dawkins, yes. Five voted aye.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Lancaster, seconded by Commissioner Wigfall, to approve beer license for the Circle K Stores, Inc., 1200 S Cedar Avenue. Roll call vote: Commissioner Lancaster, yes; Commissioner Wigfall, yes; Commissioner Powers, yes; Commissioner King, yes; Mayor Dawkins, yes. Five voted aye.

The Princess Theater Contract was not complete and ready for presentation at this meeting.

A **Motion** was made by Commissioner Wigfall, seconded by Commissioner Lancaster, to continue mowing the property located on Highway 72 (entrance way to our city). Roll call vote: Commissioner Lancaster, yes; Commissioner Wigfall, yes; Commissioner Powers, abstain; Commissioner King, no; Mayor Dawkins, yes. Three voted aye.

A **Motion** to adjourn the meeting was made by Commissioner Wigfall, seconded by Commissioner Powers. Roll call vote: Commissioner Lancaster, yes; Commissioner Wigfall, yes; Commissioner Powers, yes; Commissioner King, yes; Mayor Dawkins, yes. Five voted aye.
