A motion was made by Commissioner Woodfin, seconded by Commissioner Stone, to approve the 1st reading of Ordinance 803 – An Ordinance of The City of South Pittsburg, Tennessee To Amend and Restate in Its Entirety Title 17, Refuse and Trash Disposal, Chapter 1, Refuse Storage and Collection and Chapter 2 Pickup of Brush, Furniture and Appliances of The City of South Pittsburg Municipal Code. A **motion** was made by Commissioner Stone, **Seconded** by Commissioner Woodfin to approve **Resolution 1005 – Marion County Mitigation Plan.** Roll call vote: Commissioner Haley, yes; Commissioner Woodfin, yes; Commissioner Stone, yes; Vice Mayor Lancaster, yes; Mayor Rector, yes. Five voted ayes.

Closing of McReynolds Street (Between SPHA and Color Craft) – Tabled.
